THE 1007 NUMBERED SPECIES included on the check-list are of regular occurrence on the mainland, offshore islands, and oceanic waters within 200 miles of Mexican territory or halfway to the nearest foreign territory, whichever is closer. Forms **ENDEMIC TO MEXICO** are shown in boldfaced capitals. The **regional endemics** shown in lower-case boldface range from Mexico into northern Central America (north of Costa Rica) or the borderlands of the United States. Authority for taxonomy and nomenclature in the present list: American Ornithologists' Union. 1998. *Check-list of North American Birds*. 7th edition. American Ornithologists' Union, Washington, D.C. (and Supplements in *Auk*, through 2008).

Numerous distinctive taxa proposed for consideration as full species by various authors, but not presently recognized by the AOU, are shown indented and unnumbered. Although these are all "Groups," by definition, only those taxa consisting of more than one subspecies are labeled "Group" on the check-list. Common names are provided for convenience only. We have tried to use prevailing names whenever possible, but without making an exhaustive search of the literature. Many are unofficial placeholders of our own devising. Please consult the separate *Notes on the Check-List* document for discussion and references for all indented taxa.

An additional 72 species that have been recorded only as accidental visitors, or that appear to be extirpated from Mexico, or that are considered to be extinct in the wild, are listed separately below.
